10 Week Commitment

- SINGLE PAYMENT PLAN:** \$20/week = **\$200 total** (\$20 x 10 weeks)

- TWO PAYMENT PLAN:** \$20/week = **Two payments of \$100** (\$20 x 5 weeks)
 • **Payment due dates: March 3rd and April 7th**

5 Week Commitment

- SINGLE PAYMENT PLAN:** \$25/week = **\$125 total** (\$25 x 5 weeks)

As a member of the Crooked Sky Farms – PolyHarvest Community Supported Agriculture Project, I understand that I am making a commitment to support a regional farmer and to share in the rewards and the risks of the farmer's harvests. I agree to pay my subscription payment in full in advance of the session, or based on the payment plan schedule I have chosen. I am contracting to receive a designated share of weekly produce available at the designated pick-up site. I understand that my share does not guarantee me an exact amount or selection of produce. I also understand that my payments are non-refundable. It is my responsibility to pick up my share weekly at the designated time and place and bring my own box/bag to gather my share. I understand that if I am out of town or otherwise unable to receive my share at any time during the season, I am responsible for contacting a friend or neighbor to gather my produce, and that my share will be donated for use by the ASU Nutrition Students or House of Refuge if it is unclaimed within the designated times on pick-up days.

Share Gathering Information

Sign-in

When you arrive to pick up your share, sign next to your name on the sign-in sheet. When you are unable to pick up your produce on pickup day, we recommend that you ask a friend or neighbor to pick up for you. They should provide their name in your place on the sign-in sheet.

Gather your produce

Each week we will bring about 8 items of seasonally available produce designated to comprise your share. Your weekly share portions will be listed at pickup site. Bring your own bags to gather your produce. The produce will be in various crates at the pick-up site. Take the indicated portion from each crate. You may wish to bring a cooler and ice pack to keep your produce in if your produce will be sitting at work all day. The amount of produce available on any given pickup day is weighed and counted, to be divided evenly among all shares. Share portions of loose items will be pre-bagged, and counts of larger items will be specific. This avoids the need for weighing and extra handling on-site. Please do not pick through items to get the best looking or the largest item. Heirloom vegetables are bred for flavor, not for looks or shelf life, therefore, they tend to bruise and spoil very easily if handled repeatedly. Your produce will last at least a week if handled gently.

Trading Basket / Donations

A designated Basket will be provided with a few extra portions of each item. You may trade one portion from your share with one portion from the Trading Basket. The opportunity to trade is limited to what is in the Trading Basket, or private agreements you might make with other members. Your favorite veggie will not always be available. You are supporting the diversity of farm produce, which supports the health of the soil, the farmer, and yourself. Use this opportunity to try new, old (heirloom), and climate/environmentally appropriate crops!!

Please trade ONLY with items available in the trading basket; do not trade among the pickup crates or the surplus basket. In addition, please trade by portions (portions are the quantities indicated on the whiteboard): if today's share includes 6 potatoes and 2 onions, 6 potatoes should be placed in the trading basket and 2 onions taken out of it. Please do not trade partial portions.

If you don't want your share of potatoes and there is nothing in the trading basket for which you want to trade, please leave your potatoes in the trading basket for another member's enjoyment. Produce donated or unclaimed by the end of pickup hours is donated for use by the ASU Nutrition students.

E-mail

We will use the e-mail address you provide on your contract to send weekly notices about your share, and recipes you might try using various produce in the share. Let us know if you prefer me to send to an alternate e-mail address, or if you would prefer me not to send the e-mail messages to you. Be sure to ask Christopher Wharton on-site if you need paper copies of the weekly newsletters or recipes.

Delivery Delays

In the event of an emergency that delays or prevents the pickup, an e-mail announcement will be broadcast as early as possible, to avoid your making an extra trip to the pickup site. It is recommended that you check your e-mail for such an event prior to leaving to pick up your share. You will be notified by e-mail near the end of the season to provide an opportunity to renew for the following season.
